Community Based Training	\$70/participant minimum 15 participants	A 3 hour safeTALK training facilitated by a Forefront Master Trainer; Certificate of Completion which can be used for Continuing Education Units; and safeTALK resource book
Agency Based Training	\$1,050 per training minimum of 10 participants, maximum of 30*	Agency can have up to 30 participants receive 3 hour safeTALK training, facilitated by a Forefront Master Trainer; Certificate of Completion and safeTALK resource book
4-Hour School Based Training (Schools only wishing for the standard 3-hour safeTALK use Agency Based Pricing)	\$1,200 per training minimum of 10 participants, maximum of 30*	Schools can have up to 30 participants receive 3 hour safeTALK training facilitated by a Forefront Master including additional customized 1-hour supplemental training specific to school-based prevention, intervention, re-entry and post-vention best practices; Certificate of Completion and safeTALK resource book

*Forefront can increase the maximum number of participants to 40 with the use of a second trainer. The additional cost is \$450.
